



Co-product market report

March 2022

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Beef Co-products

This report has been hampered by the flood events down the east coast with many of our contributors' businesses being heavily impacted. We wish them a speedy recovery from the damage caused to their businesses and homes.

Beef offal prices in February were steady to softer across most items while rumen pillars, tripe pieces and tendon prices firmed.



Head offal

Head meat averaged \$6.30/kg which was \$1.35/kg higher year-on-year but 20¢/kg below last month. Cheek meat was \$2.05/kg dearer than year-ago levels, averaging \$9.77/kg, to be 7¢/kg higher month-on-month.


Lip export prices to the US and Mexico eased 29 ¢/kg month-on-month, averaging \$4.35/kg to be 42 ¢/kg up on last year. Halal lips averaged \$4.81/kg to be \$1.06/kg firmer than February 2021 but 19 ¢/kg lower than last month.



Beef offal trends

Omasum eased 23¢/kg from last month, to average \$7.17/kg, up 91¢/kg from year-ago prices. Halal omasum averaged \$7.35/kg, up \$1.05/kg year-on-year but 20¢/kg down month-on month.

Halal tripe pieces averaged 3.23/kg up 43¢/kg year-on-year and 40¢/kg firmer than last month. Non-halal tripe pieces were 17¢/kg down year-on-year but 15¢/kg lower than January to average 2.38/kg. Honeycomb tripe averaged 6.85/kg to be 45¢/kg below year ago prices and 18¢/kg down on last month.




Beef offal trends continued...

Aorta eased to average \$9.17/kg down 18¢/kg month-on-month but \$1.59/kg above the February 2021 price.


Heart prices were down from last month, averaging \$2.71/kg, to be 71¢/kg below year-ago levels and 3¢/kg below the January price. Halal hearts averaged \$3.39/kg, easing 15¢/kg month-on-month and down 36¢/kg from February 2021.

Kidneys were not reported while lungs realised \$2.15/kg down 45¢/kg from year ago levels and 93¢/kg softer month-on-month, while halal lungs averaged \$4.85/kg, up \$2.66/kg year-on-year but 5¢/kg lower than last month.


Figure 4: Trends in beef offal prices



Beef offal trends continued...

Liver prices averaged \$1.76/kg, down 14¢/kg month-on-month but 36¢/kg firmer than year-ago levels. Halal livers were 5¢/kg down on last month's price to average \$2.01/kg to be up 18¢/kg on last year prices.

Figure 5: Trends in beef offal prices




Japanese and Korean Offals

Tongue prices were \$3.35/kg down from January to average \$2100/kg and were \$7.77/kg above year-ago levels.

Thick skirt was \$1.80/kg higher year-on-year and \$2.12/kg softer than last month, averaging \$10.50/kg. Thin skirt averaged \$10.25/kg, down \$2.68/kg from December but \$1.42/kg above year-ago prices.

Rumen pillars firmed with heavy weight product averaging \$11.08/kg, up 91¢/kg month-on-month and \$1.41/kg higher than February 2021 levels.


Figure 6: Trends in Japanese offal prices



Tails and Tendons

Tail prices eased \$2.68/kg from last month, averaging \$17.50/kg, to be \$6.08/kg above year-ago levels. Halal tails averaged \$18.76/kg, down 57¢/kg from last month but \$7.36/kg above year-ago prices. Tendons averaged \$12.15/kg to be \$3.97/kg above February 2021 price and \$1.55/kg up on last month.

Sheep Co-products

Sheep offal prices were steady with liver under downward pressure.



Sheep offal

Sheep hearts averaged \$4.82/kg, up 5ϕ /kg month-on-month and \$1.07/kg dearer than year-ago levels. Sheep kidneys were reported at \$5.62/kg which was 79ϕ /kg above January price. Sheep liver averaged \$1.76/kg to be 81ϕ /kg softer month-on-month but 16ϕ /kg higher than February 2021.


Sheep tripe was not reported this month. Long cut tongues averaged \$5.85/kg up 5¢/kg month-on-month.





Lamb runners averaged \$6.45/piece firming \$1.83/piece year-on-year and 43¢/piece down from February while sheep runners were reported at \$5.28/piece, down 49¢/piece month-on-month and up \$1.78/piece year-on-year..




The average foetal calf blood price has firmed \$153.33/litre year-on-year to average \$613.33/litre, up \$15.83 on last month.

Rendered products

Rendered products remained firm with tallow prices remaining very strong based on biofuel demand from Singapore and the USA coupled with reduced production.



The price for 50% protein MBM eased \$62/tonne from last month, averaging \$741/tonne which was \$59/tonne above February 2021 levels. Blood meal averaged \$1450/tonne, up \$320/tonne compared with last year's price, and \$107.50/tonne firmer month-on-month.

Tallow prices were very firm, with the price for 1% FFA tallow averaging \$2240/tonne, up \$1135/tonne from February 2021 and \$260/tonne above last month price.

Hides

The hide market remains steady however orders are lighter than usual for the period whilst shipping costs continue to rise with all parties of the transport chain blaming the other for the massive increases and consumers wearing the cost.


Figure 13: Trends in hide prices (East Coast Ex Works)
