Beef Co-products

Beef offal prices in December firmed across most items with rumen pillars tails and tendons leading the way.

Head offal

Head meat averaged 5.60/kg which was 17¢/kg lower year-on-year and 18¢/kg lowerr than last month. Cheek meat was 2.63/kg below year-ago levels, averaging 7.87/kg, up 25¢/kg month-on-month.

Lip export prices to the US and Mexico were firmer by $16 \/kg$ month-on-month, averaging \$3.10/kg but \$1.05/kg down on last year. Halal lips averaged \$3.79/kg to be $89 \/kg$ softer than December 2022 and $12 \/kg$ lower than last month.





Figure 1: Trends in beef head offal prices

Beef offal trends

Omasum traded 8 ¢/kg down from last month, to average \$4.92/kg, down \$4.65/kg from year-ago prices. Halal omasum averaged \$4.72kg, down \$4.45/kg year-on-year and 34¢/kg softer month-on month.

Halal tripe pieces averaged \$2.48/kg which is even year-on-year and 33¢/kg above last month. Non-halal tripe pieces averaged \$2.00/kg to be 20¢/kg softer year-on-year but 16¢/kg up month-on-month. Honeycomb tripe averaged \$6.85/kg to be \$1.22/kg below year ago prices but 15¢/kg firmer than last month.





Beef offal trends continued...

Aorta was reported at \$9.51/kg which was \$1.29/kg below year ago prices but 41¢/g firmer month-on-month.

Heart prices were even with last month averaging \$2.71/kg, to be 59¢/kg below year ago levels. Halal hearts averaged \$2.68/kg, easing 29¢/kg month-on-month to be down 67¢/kg from last December.


Figure 3: Trends in beef offal prices



Kidneys were not reported.

Halal lungs averaged \$2.13/kg, down \$1.52/kg year-on-year and eased 16¢/kg from last month. Non-halal lungs averaged \$1.65/kg to be 28¢/kg softer year-on-year but up 5¢/kg month-on-month.


Figure 4: Trends in beef offal prices



Beef offal trends continued...

Liver prices averaged \$1.60kg, up 19¢/kg month-on-month but 40¢/kg softer than year-ago levels. Halal livers were 6¢/kg up from last month's price to average \$1.57/kg which was down 44¢/kg compared to last year prices.

Figure 5: Trends in beef offal prices




Japanese and Korean Offals

Swiss cut tongue averaged \$13.61/kg which was 19¢/kg below year ago price but72¢/kg up month-on-month.

Thick skirt was \$2.58/kg softer year-on-year but 14ϕ /kg up from last month, averaging \$9.02/kg. Thin skirt averaged \$8.90/kg to be 27ϕ /kg above last month but \$2.45/kg down year-on-year.

Rumen pillars firmed with heavy weight product averaging 16.03/kg, up 79¢/kg month-on-month and 2.48/kg higher than December 2022 levels.


Figure 6: Trends in Japanese offal prices



Tails and Tendons

Tail prices were up 56¢/kg month-on-month averaging \$11.80/kg and \$1.80/kg above year-ago levels. Halal tails averaged \$11.91/kg, down 46¢/kg from last month but \$1.24/kg above year-ago prices. Tendons averaged \$10.34/kg to be 76¢/kg lower year-on-year and \$1.59/kg up from last month.

Sheep Co-products

Sheep offal prices were softer this month however kidneys recovered from last month and runners remain weak.


Sheep offal

Sheep hearts averaged \$1.93/kg, down 53¢/kg month-on-month and \$4.40/kg cheaper than year-ago levels. Sheep kidneys averaged \$3.17 this month to be \$1.66/kg lower year-on-year but \$1.29/kg up on last month. Sheep liver averaged \$2.83/kg to be 17¢/kg softer month-on-month but 62¢/kg higher than December 2022.

Sheep tripe averaged \$3.30/kg down 40¢/kg from last month and 90¢/kg softer year-on-year.


Long cut tongues were not reported.

Lamb runners averaged \$4.93/piece down \$1.40/piece year-on-year but \$1.76/piece firmer than November while sheep runners were reported at \$3.93/piece, up \$1.76/piece month-on-month but \$2.07/piece softer year-on-year.

Pharmaceutical products

Pharmaceutical products were relatively stable but foetal blood prices are expected to ease as longer-term contracts expire.



Rendered meals were steady to firm whilst average tallow prices firmed slightly.



The price for 50% protein MBM firmed \$8/tonne from last month, averaging \$840/tonne which was \$102/tonne below December 2022 levels. Blood meal averaged \$1507/tonne to be up \$192/tonne from last year and up \$18/tonne month-on-month.

Tallow prices were firmer with the price for 1% FFA tallow averaging \$1975/tonne, down \$572/tonne year-on-year but \$24/tonne above last month's price.

Hides

The market is steady to easier for heavier good quality hides with tanneries losing some interest whilst shoe leather remains stagnant.




Figure 13: Trends in hide prices (East Coast Ex Works)
