Beef Co-products

Beef offal prices in February remained firm to steady across most items with halal tails firmer and tendons easier.

Head offal

Head meat averaged \$5.33/kg which was 1,42/kg lower year-on-year but 4,42/kg higher than last month. Cheek meat was 1,42/kg above year-ago levels, averaging 8.00/kg, but down 4,42/kg month-on-month.

Lip export prices to the US and Mexico were firmer by 41¢/kg month-on-month, averaging \$3.58/kg but 22¢/kg down on last year. Halal lips averaged \$3.79/kg to be 54¢/kg softer than last February and 1¢/kg higher than last month.





Figure 1: Trends in beef head offal prices

Beef offal trends

Omasum traded \$1.02/kg up from last month, to average \$6.31/kg, down \$1.94/kg from year-ago prices. Halal omasum averaged \$6.11/kg, down \$1.22/kg year-on-year but 97¢/kg firmer month-on month.

Halal tripe pieces averaged \$2.34/kg which is 11¢/kg down year-on-year and 35¢/kg below last month. Non-halal tripe pieces averaged \$1.92/kg to be 35¢/kg softer year-on-year and 19¢/kg down month-on-month. Honeycomb tripe averaged \$6.40/kg to be \$1.35/kg below year ago prices and 16¢/kg lower than last month.





Beef offal trends continued...

Aorta was reported at \$9.49/kg which was \$1.59/kg above year ago prices but 8¢/g softer month-on-month.

Heart prices were down 35¢/kg from last month averaging \$2.34/kg, to be 11¢/kg below year ago levels. Halal hearts averaged \$2.86/kg, firming 1¢/kg month-on-month to be down 28¢/kg from last January.


Figure 3: Trends in beef offal prices



Kidneys were not reported.

Halal lungs averaged 2.29/kg, down 26¢/kg year-on-year but firmed 15¢/kg from last month. Non-halal lungs averaged 1.80/kg to be 10¢/kg softer year-on-year but 15¢/kg firmer month-on-month.

Beef offal trends continued...

Liver prices averaged \$1.60kg, down 15¢/kg month-on-month and 54¢/kg softer than year-ago levels. Halal livers were 5¢/kg up from last month's price to average \$1.77/kg which was down 15¢/kg compared to last year prices.

Figure 5: Trends in beef offal prices




Japanese and Korean Offals

Swiss cut tongue averaged \$15.11/kg which was \$4.13/kg above year ago price and \$1.39/kg up month-on-month.

Thick skirt was \$1.57/kg softer year-on-year but 8¢/kg up from last month, averaging \$8.73/kg. Thin skirt averaged \$8.68/kg to be 3¢/kg above last month but \$1.77/kg down year-on-year.

Rumen pillars firmed with heavy weight product averaging \$16.14/kg, up 22¢/kg month-on-month and \$4.24/kg higher than February 2023 levels.


Figure 6: Trends in Japanese offal prices



Tails and Tendons

Tail prices were down 71¢/kg month-on-month averaging \$10.77/kg but \$2.47/kg above year-ago levels. Halal tails averaged \$12.18/kg, up \$1.10/kg from last month but \$2.19/kg above year-ago prices. Tendons averaged \$7.80/kg to be \$2.60/kg lower year-on-year and \$1.10/kg down from last month.

Sheep Co-products

Sheep offal prices were softer this month however hearts firmed whilst runners continue to weaken.



Sheep offal

Sheep hearts averaged \$3.85/kg, up \$1.78/kg month-on-month but 8ϕ /kg cheaper than year-ago levels. Sheep kidneys were not reported. Sheep liver averaged \$3.20/kg to be 80ϕ /kg softer month-on-month but 15ϕ /kg higher than February 2023.

Sheep tripe averaged 2.95/kg down 10¢/kg from last month and 60¢/kg firmer year-on-year. Long cut tongues were not reported.

Lamb runners averaged \$3.25/piece down \$3.60/piece year-on-year and 10¢/piece firmer than January while sheep runners were reported at \$2.10/piece, up 10¢/piece month-on-month and \$3.75/piece softer year-on-year.

Pharmaceutical products

Pharmaceutical products were relatively stable but foetal blood prices continue to ease as longer-term contracts expire.



The average foetal calf blood price is \$95/litre softer year-on-year to average \$585/litre and was \$19/litre up on last month.

Concentrated gall was reported at \$25.75/kg to be up \$1.25/kg year-on-year and down 92¢/kg from last month.

Rendered products

Rendered meals were steady to firm whilst average tallow prices are easier.

The price for 50% protein MBM eased \$30/tonne from last month, averaging \$769/tonne which was \$82/tonne below February 2023 levels. Blood meal averaged \$1499/tonne to be up \$44/tonne from last year but down \$31/tonne month-on-month.

Tallow prices remain weaker with the price for 1% FFA tallow averaging \$1397/tonne, down \$670/tonne year-on-year and \$89/tonne below last month's price.

Hides

The market is steady to easier for heavier good quality hides with tanneries continuing to buy against orders for leather whilst shoe leather remains stagnant.




Figure 13: Trends in hide prices (East Coast Ex Works)

The Australian dollar opened the month at 65.53US¢ and continued to trade relatively steadily for the rest of the month to close at 65.19US¢ to average 65.30US¢ across the month, down 1.22US¢ month-on-month, but down 3.85US¢ from February 2023.
