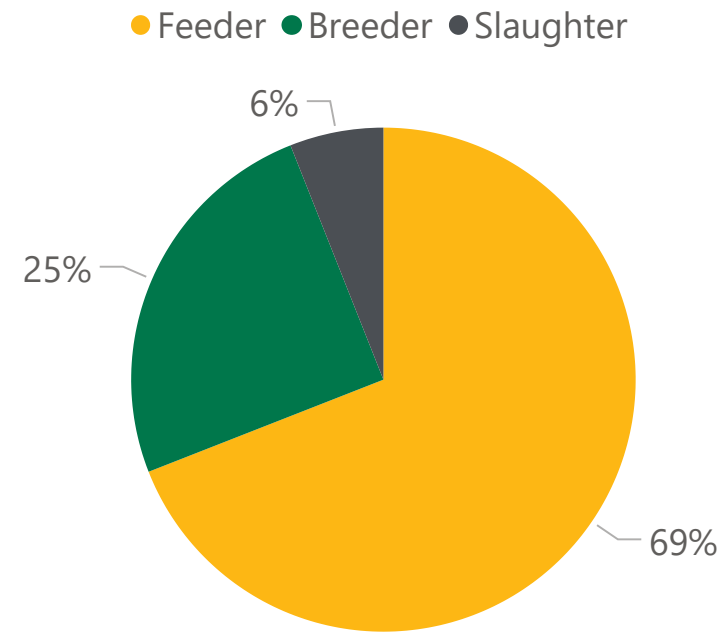

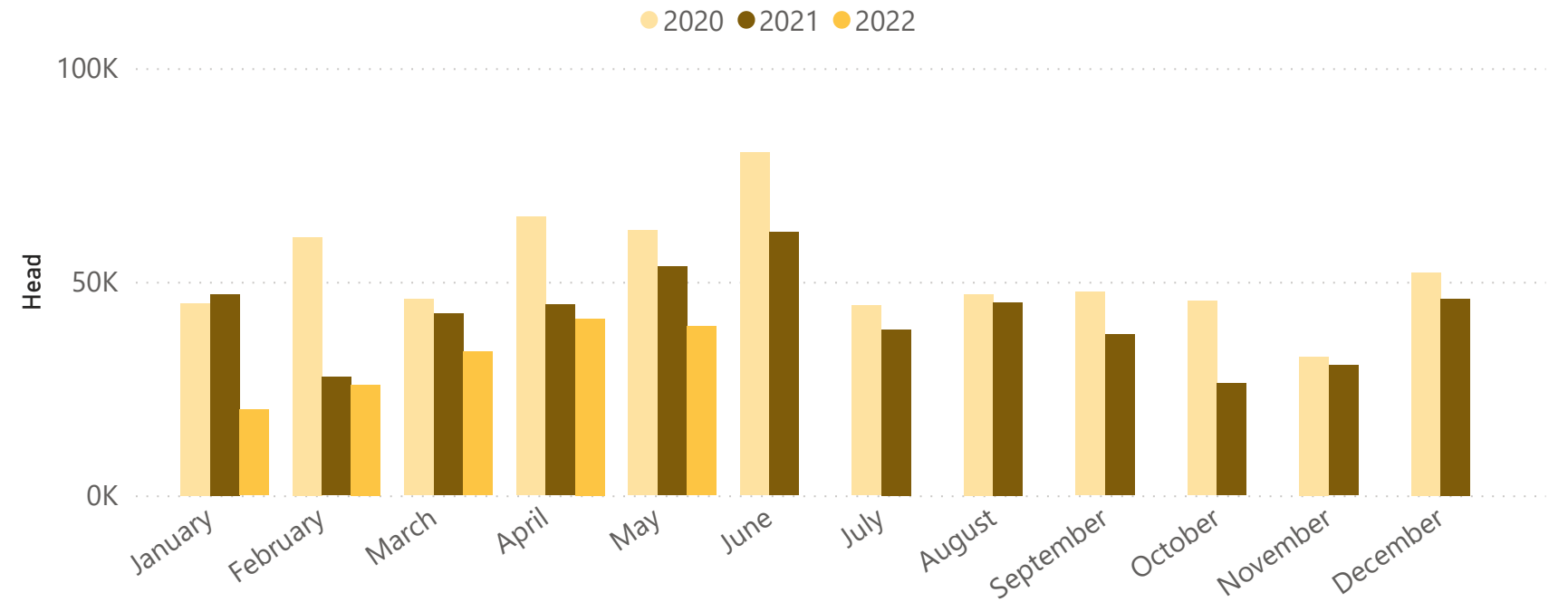

Export breakdown: calendar year-to-May



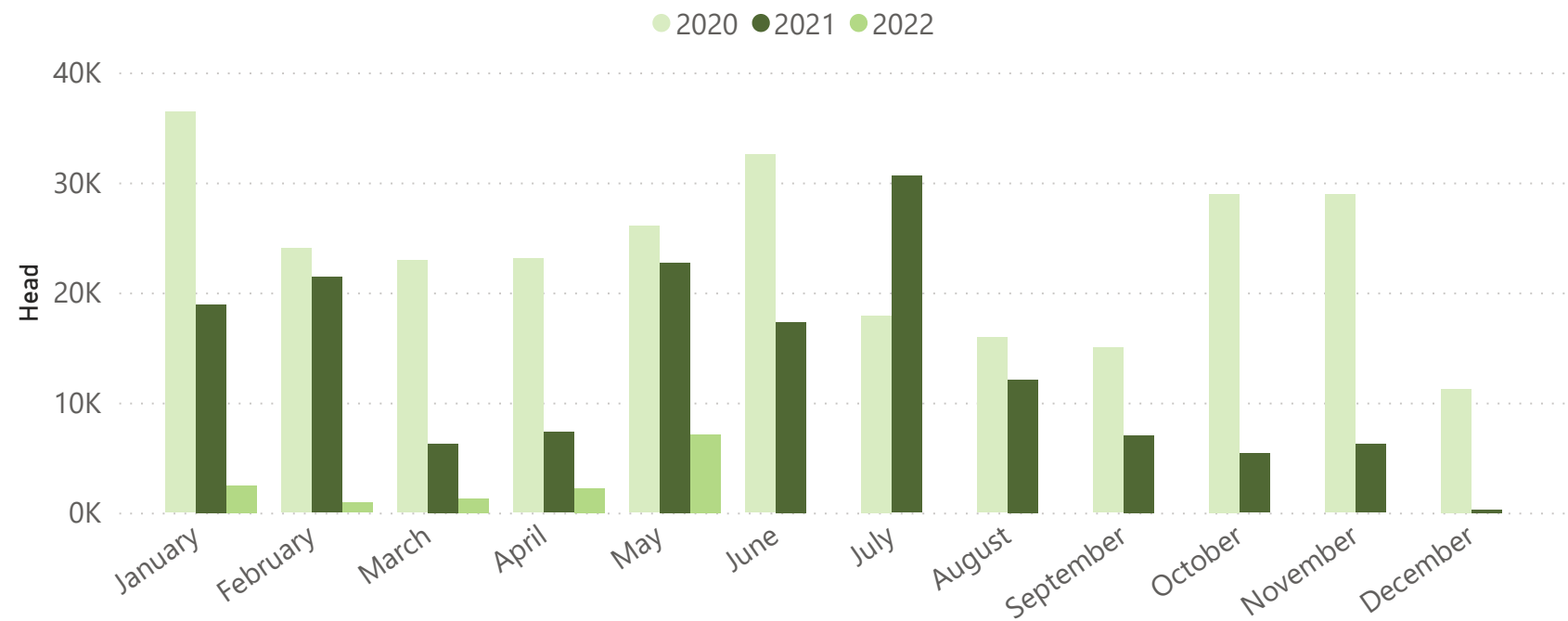

Feeder cattle - monthly



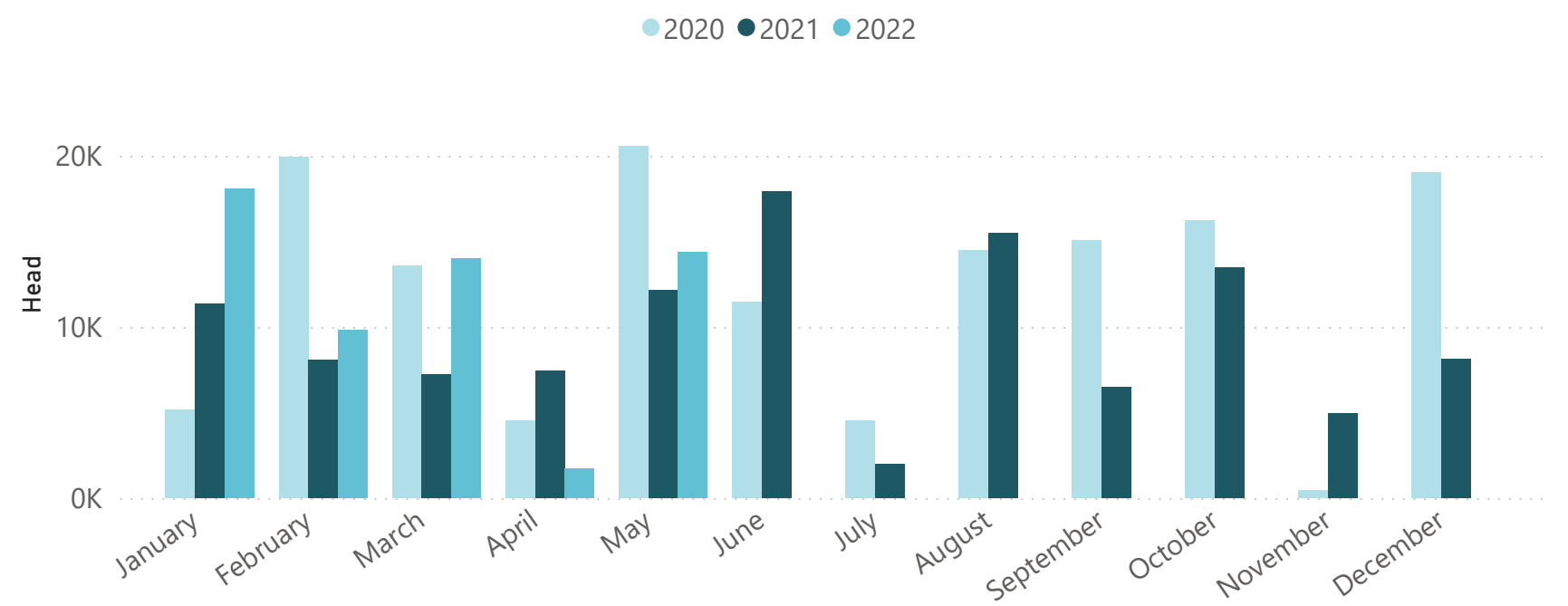

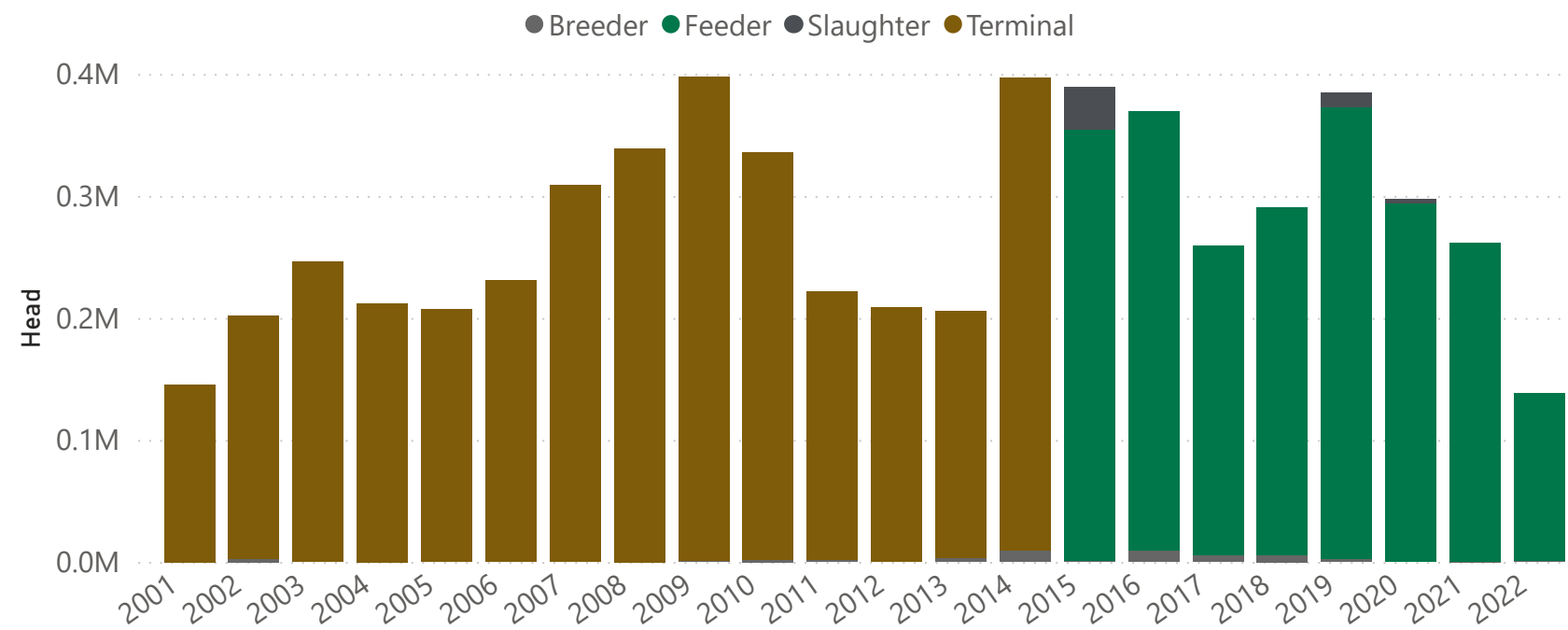

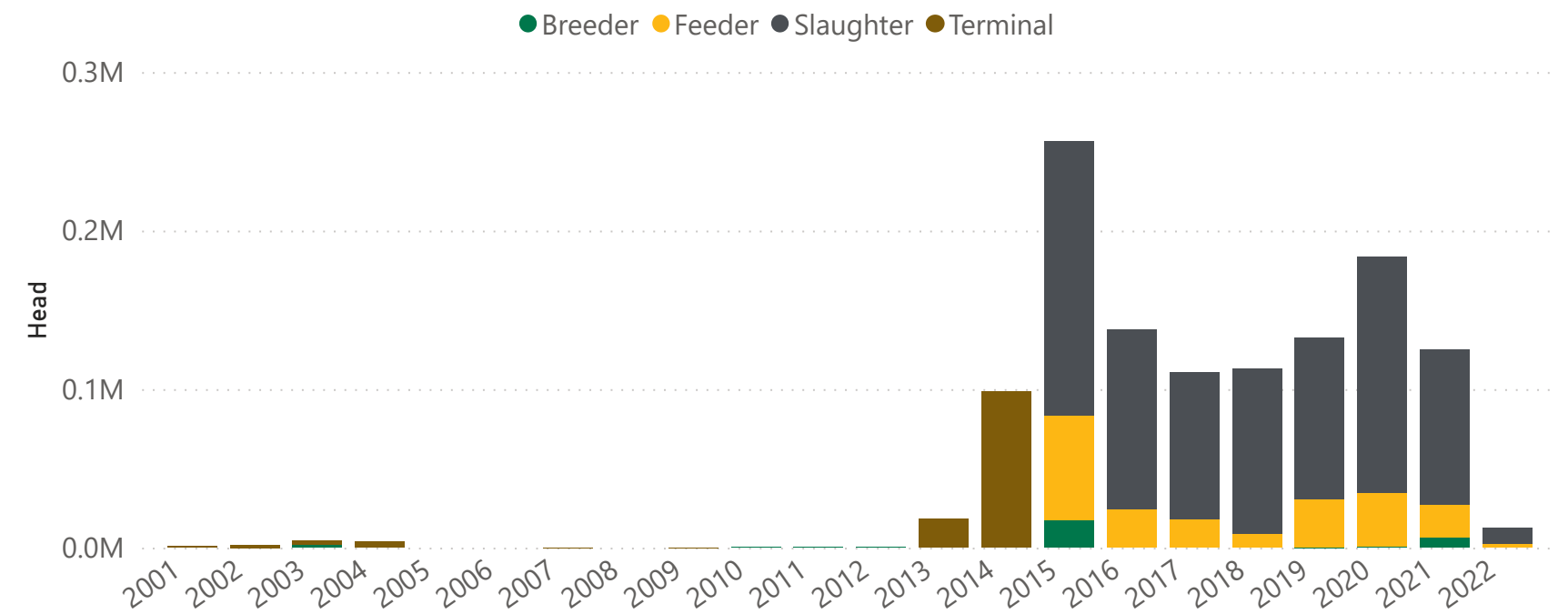

Cattle exports to Indonesia: calendar year-to-May



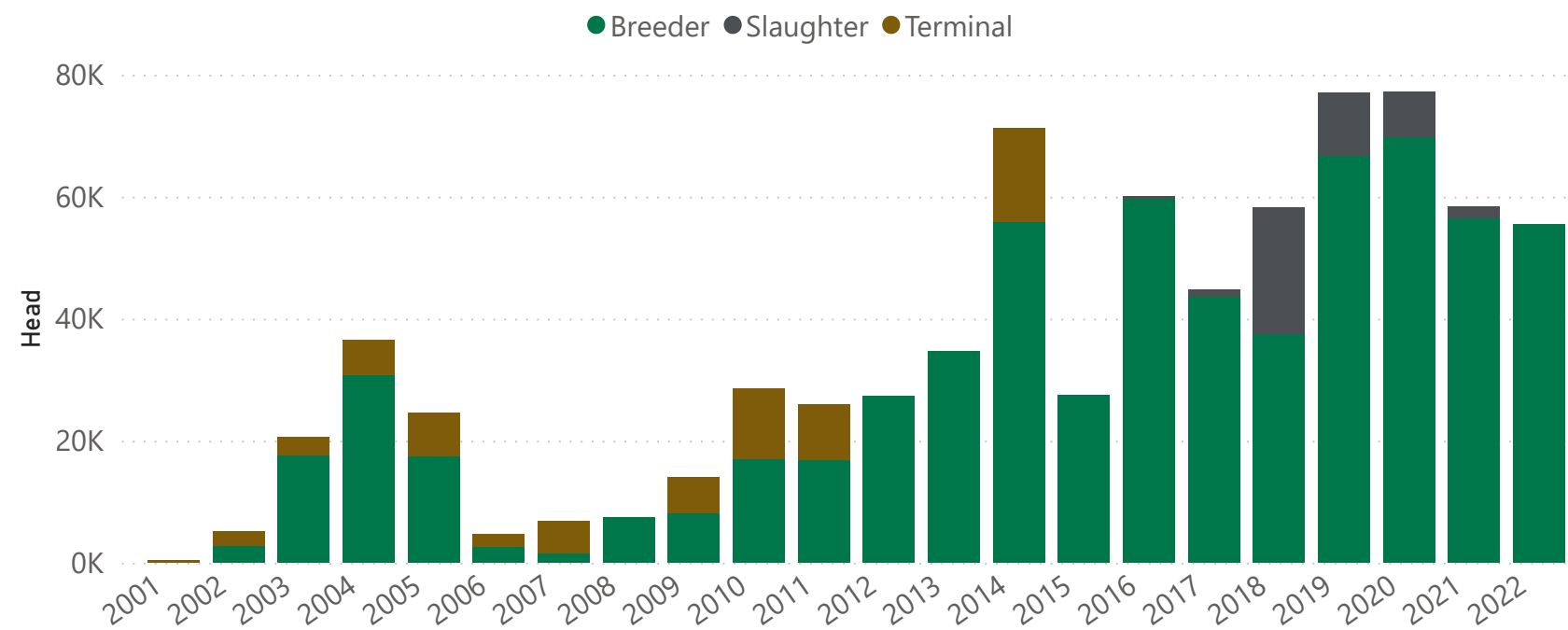

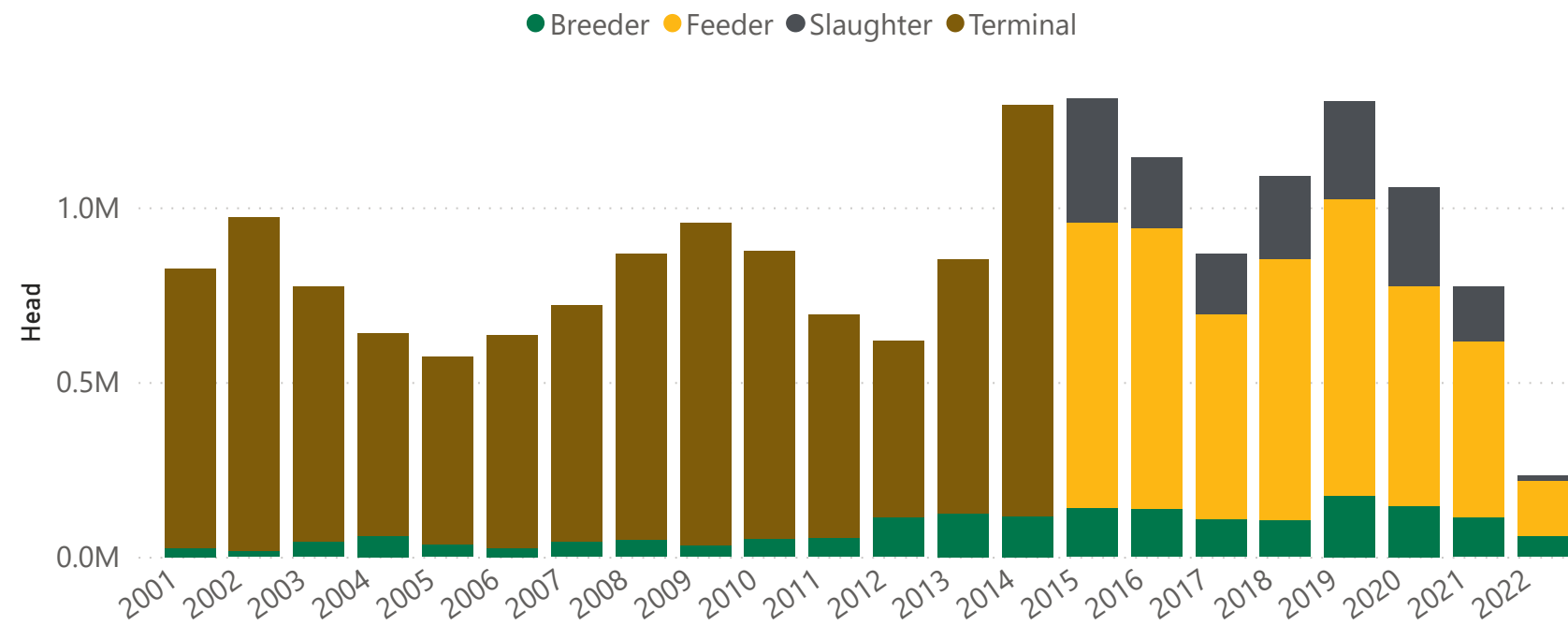

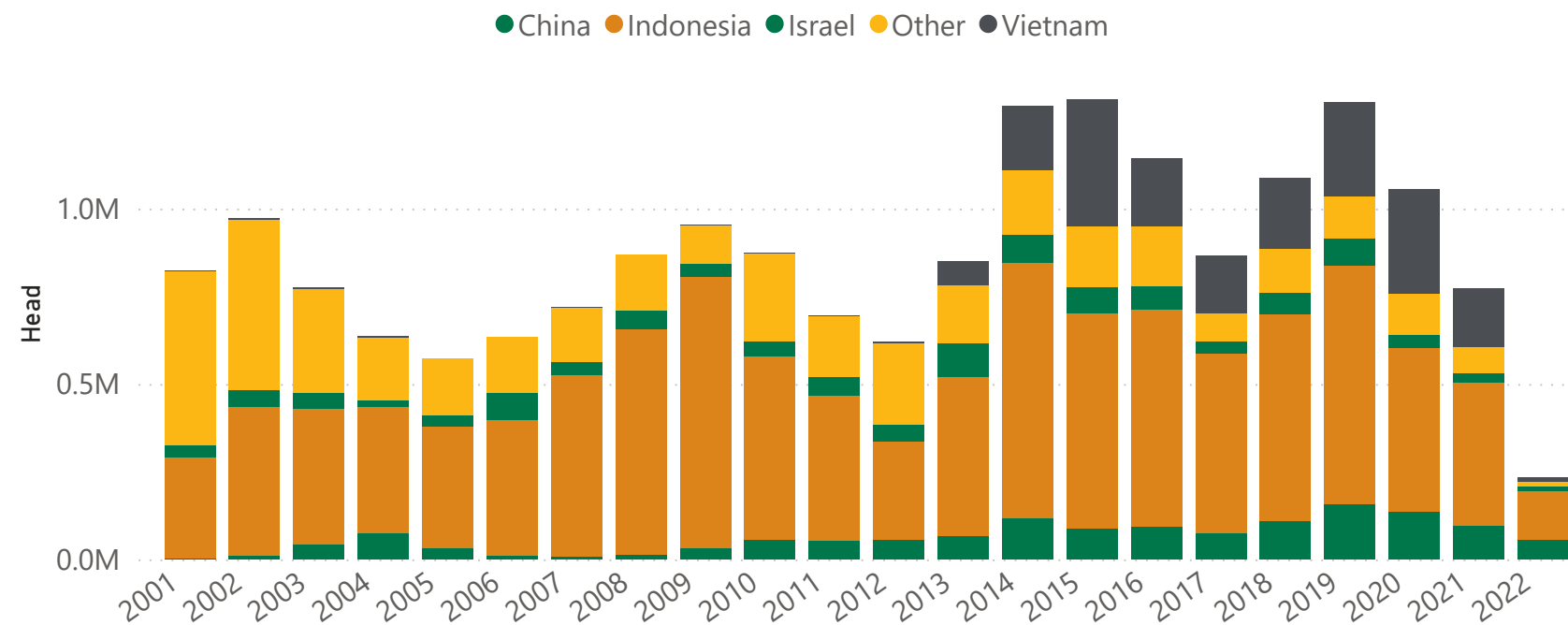

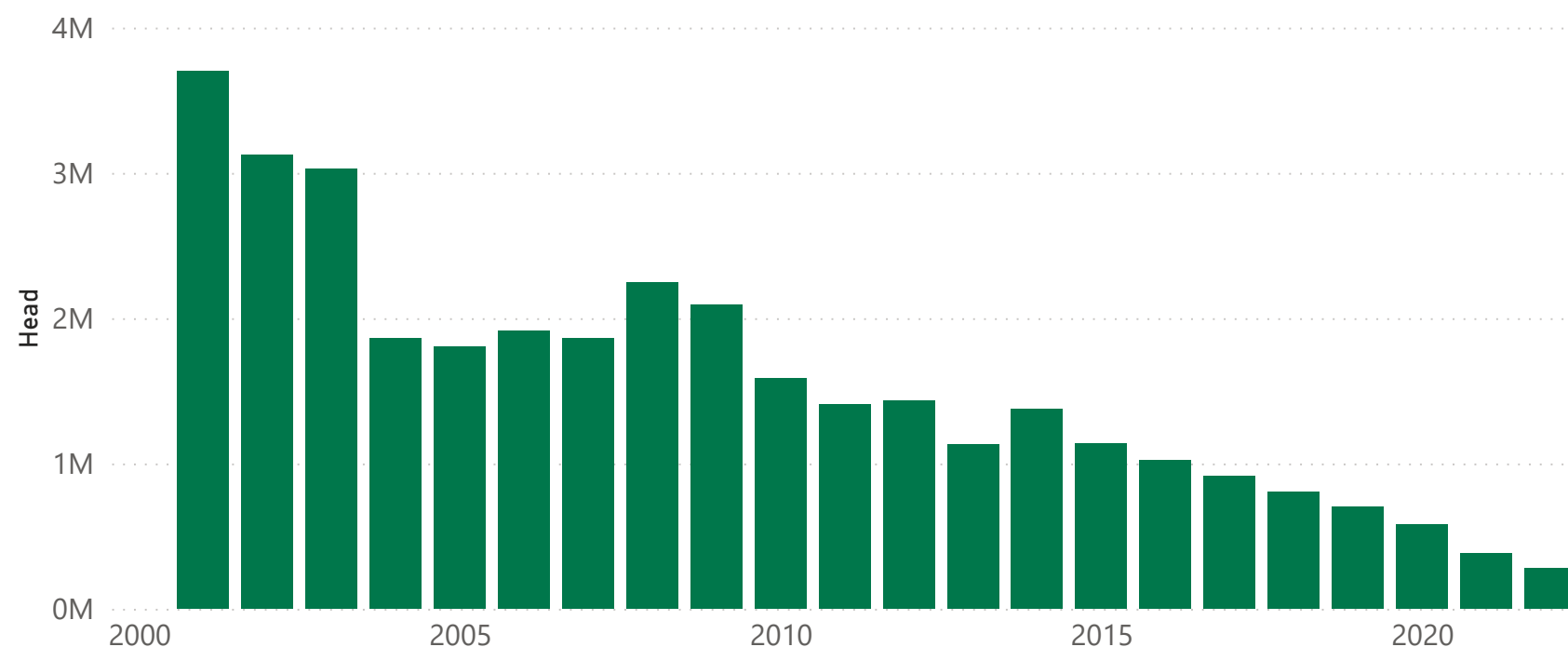

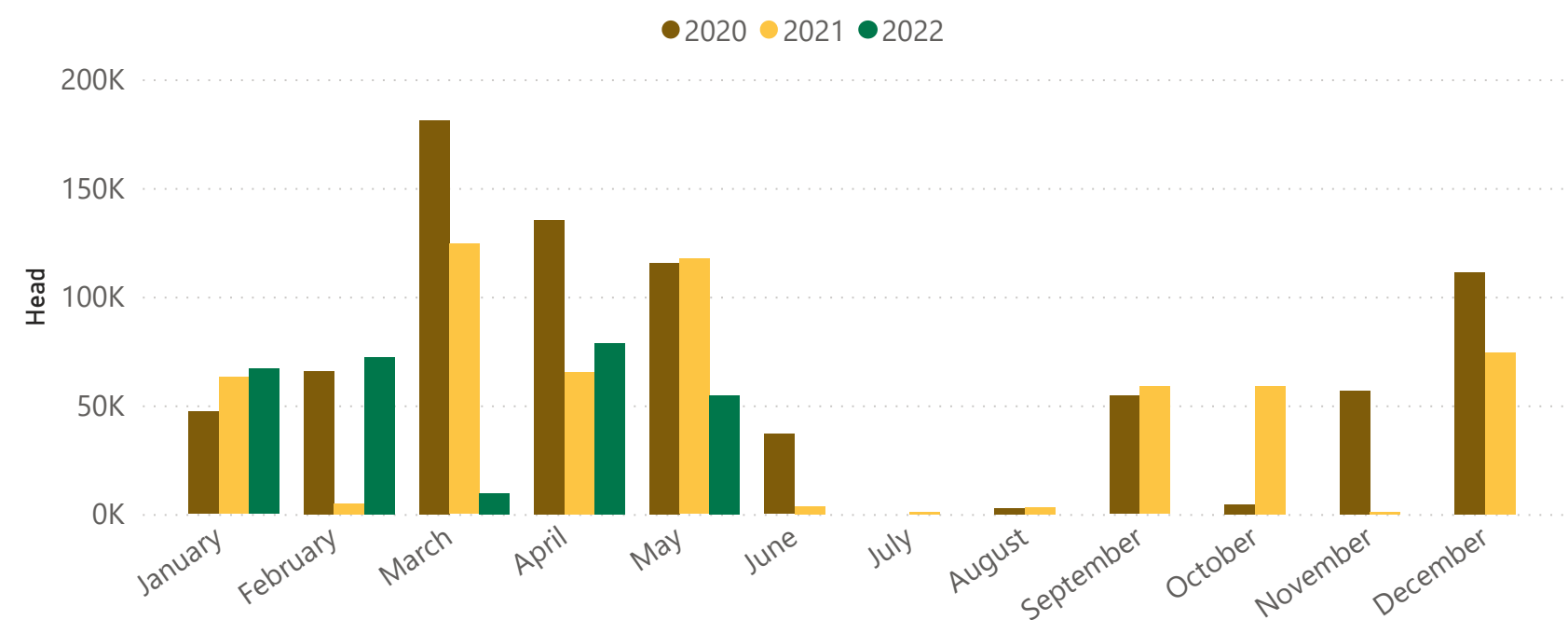

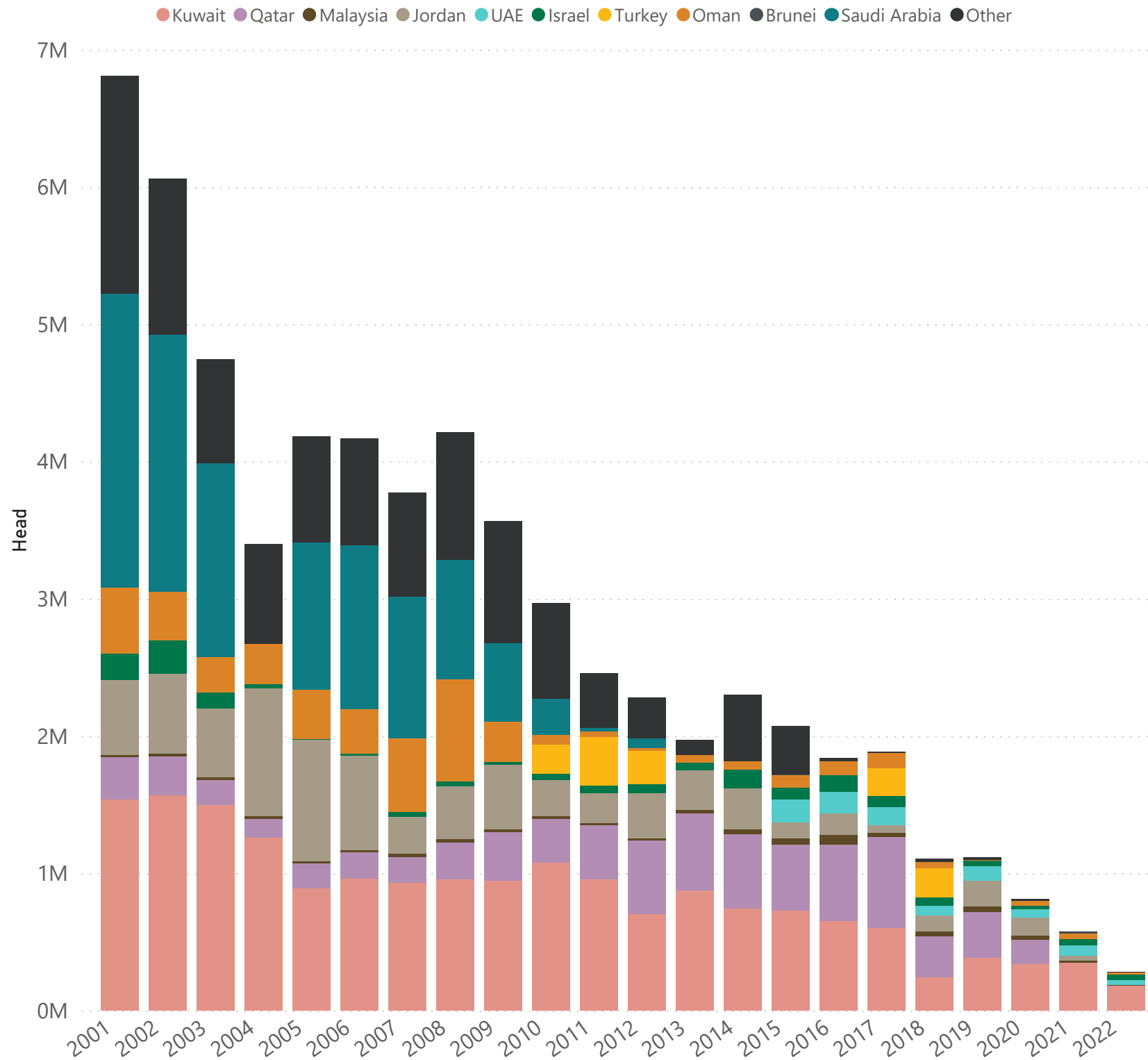

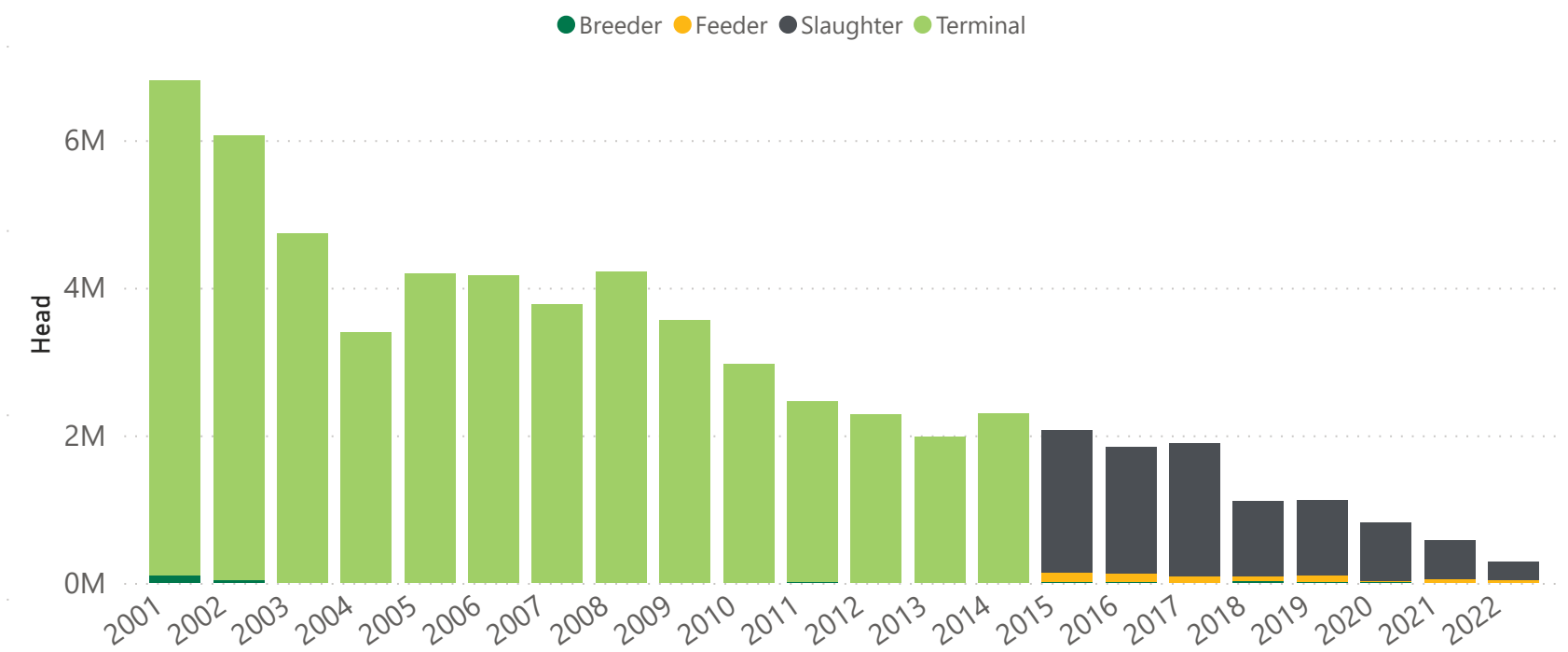

Sheep exports by category: Calendar year

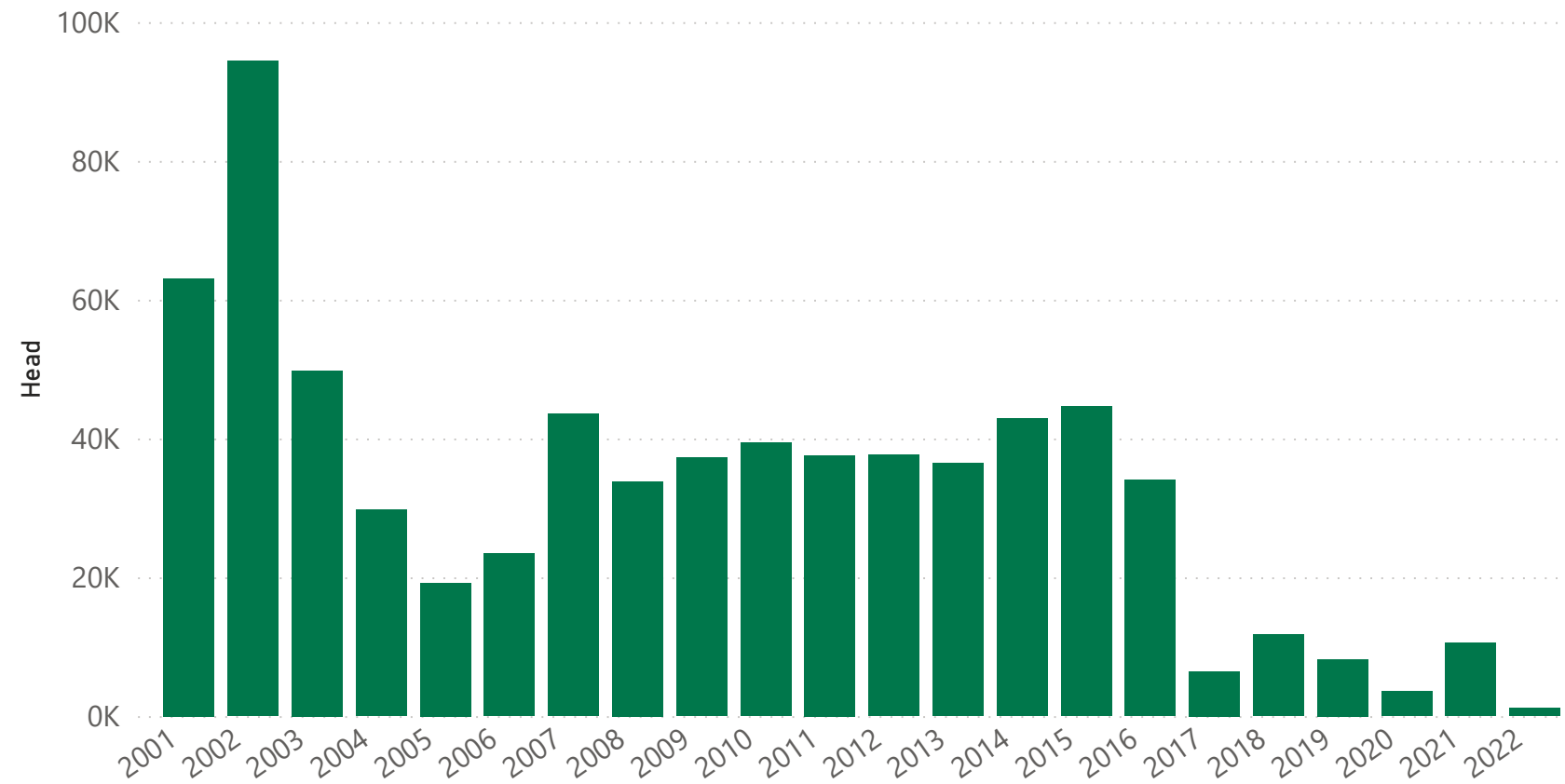

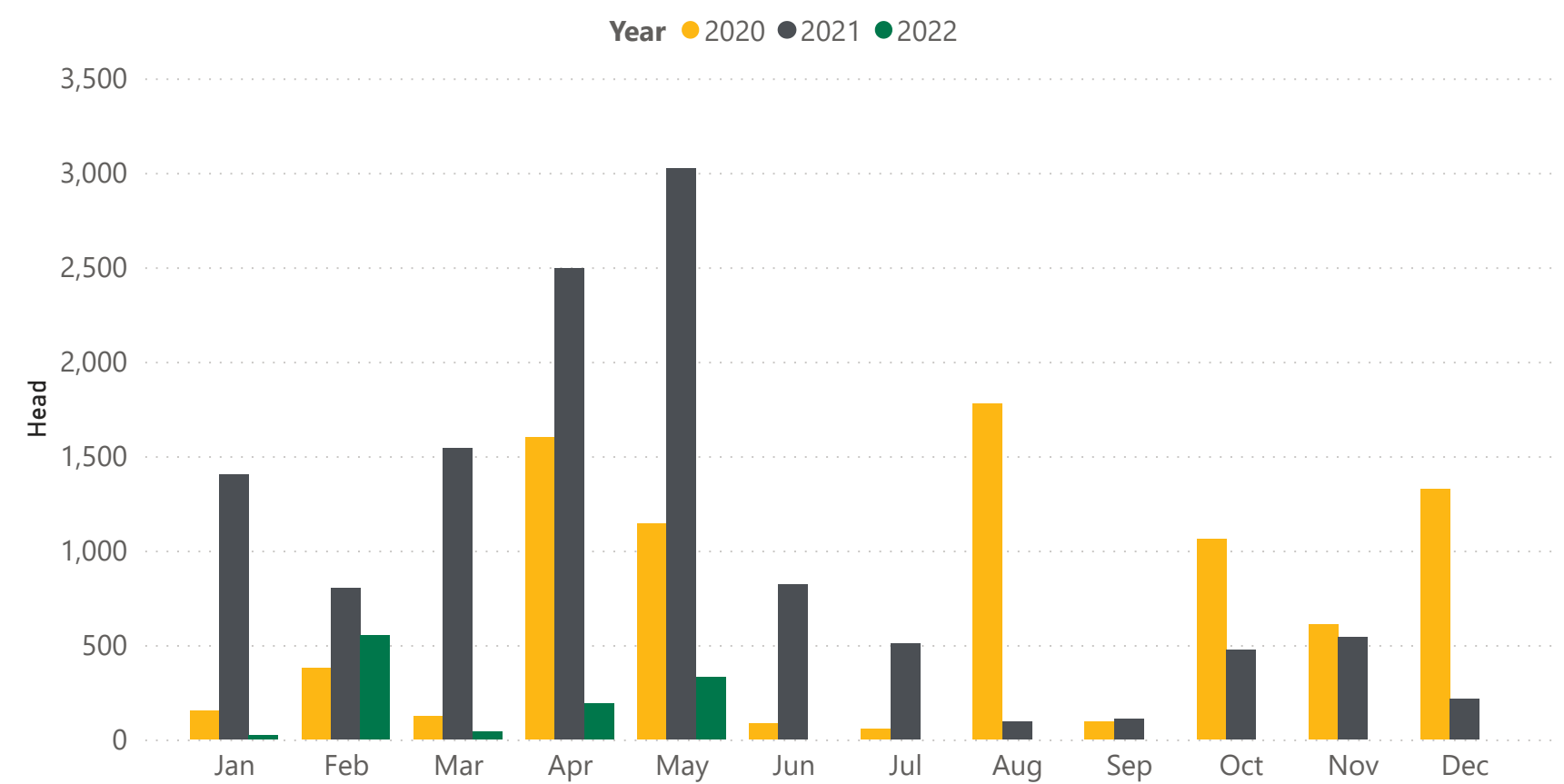
