MLA's PDS program supports producers to adapt, validate and demonstrate the business values of integrating new management practices and skills into their local farming system.

The '**Optimising Ewe Lamb Joining Outcomes**' PDS aims to demonstrate the process and additional management skills required to successfully join ewe lambs. The project began in February 2023 and will run until December 2026. We have now compiled the results from the last two years of ewe lamb joining's. This includes the 2022 drop ewe lambs, their progeny (2023 drop) and the lambs born from these progeny (2024 drop). We are excited to continue to build on this data to give insightful information.
