



# Co-product market report

April 2025

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# **Beef Co-products**

Beef offal prices in March firmed across most products however omasum which spiked last month returned to usual levels expected whilst beef lips were very firm.

#### Head offal


Head meat averaged \$5.19/kg to be 29¢/kg down from year ago price but was 39¢/kg above last month. Cheek meat was 11¢/kg above year-ago levels, averaging \$8.61/kg which is \$28¢/kg firmer than February.

Lip export prices to the US and Mexico averaged \$5.60/kg up \$1.80/kg month-on-month and \$2.28/kg up on last year. Halal lips averaged \$4.35/kg to be 38¢/kg firmer than last March and 30¢/kg up from last month.

#### Beef offal trends

Omasum was reported at 5.96/kg which was 85¢/kg up on price last year. Halal omasum averaged 6.73/kg, up 1.93/kg year-on-year but 17¢/kg softer month-on month.

Halal tripe pieces averaged \$2.59/kg which is  $34\phi$ /kg lower year-on-year but  $5\phi$ /kg above last month. Non-halal tripe pieces returned \$2.22/kg to be  $12\phi$ /kg up from last year but  $5\phi$ /kg down month-on-month. Honeycomb tripe traded at \$7.50/kg up  $86\phi$ /kg up year-on-year and \$1.25/kg firmer than last month.




#### Beef offal trends continued...

Aorta was reported at \$9.75/kg which was 31¢/kg up from year ago prices and \$2.35 firmer than last month.

Heart prices averaged \$2.78/kg, to be 51¢/kg above year ago levels and 85¢/kg up from a month ago. Halal hearts averaged \$2.97/kg, firming 35¢/kg month-on-month and up 44¢/kg from last March.






Kidneys were not reported however halal kidneys realised \$1.73/kg which was up 55¢/kg month-on-month.

Halal lungs averaged \$2.60/kg, up 84¢/kg year-on-year and 57¢/kg up from last month. Non-halal lungs were reported at \$2.15/kg up 50¢/kg year-on-year but down 10¢/kg from February.


Figure 4: Trends in beef offal prices



#### Beef offal trends continued...

Liver prices were even with year ago levels to return \$1.85/kg and up 8¢/kg on last month. Halal livers were 28¢/kg up from last month's price to average \$2.26/kg which was up 67¢/kg compared to last year prices.

Figure 5: Trends in beef offal prices




#### International Offals

Swiss cut tongue averaged \$16.34/kg up \$1.66/kg from a year ago and \$1.84/kg firmer than last month, while halal swiss cut tongues realised \$16.51/kg up \$1.57/kg month-on-month.

Thick skirt averaged \$7.08/kg down 22¢/kg from last month while thin skirt averaged \$6.98/kg down 22¢/kg from last month and down \$1.49/kg year-on-year.

Heavy weight rumen pillars were not reported but halal product averaged \$14.08/kg.


Figure 6: Trends in International offal prices



#### Tails and Tendons

Tails were reported at \$14.90/kg up \$3.13/kg year-on-year and \$2.57/kg firmer than last month. Halal tails averaged \$14.89/kg up \$1.32¢/kg month-on-month and \$3.69/kg up from last March. Tendons returned \$8.50/kg up \$2.50/kg from last month but even year-on-year.

# **Sheep Co-products**

Sheep offal prices were firmer across the board this month.



### Sheep offal

Sheep hearts averaged \$2.60/kg, up 47¢/kg month-on-month and 47¢/kg firmer than year-ago levels. Sheep kidneys made \$2.63/kg up 40¢/kg from February but 17¢/kg down year-on-year. Sheep liver averaged \$2.77/kg to be 39¢/kg firmer month-on-month but 30¢/kg down from last March.

Sheep tripe averaged 1.95kg down 90¢/kg year-on-year but 25¢/kg firmer than last month. Long cut tongues returned 4.07/kg which was 83¢/kg down on last month.

Lamb runners averaged \$3.80/piece up 10¢/piece month-on-month and sheep runners made \$2.50/piece which was also up 10¢/piece from last month but 40¢/piece firmer than a year ago.

Pharmaceutical products were steady.





The price for 50% protein MBM eased \$1/tonne from last month, averaging \$616/tonne which was \$56/tonne below March 2024 levels. Blood meal averaged \$1367/tonne to be down \$35/tonne month-on-month but \$7/tonne down from a year ago.

Tallow prices were firm with the price for 1% FFA tallow averaging \$1888/tonne, up \$605/tonne year-on-year and \$330/tonne above last month's price.

### **Hides**

The hide market remains soft with tannery orders difficult to find with continued downwards price pressure due to over-abundant hides for available orders. Buyers and sellers met at the Hong Kong Leather Fair with some business done.


