# Step 1: Confirm you are eligible

To be eligible as a member of Meat & Livestock Australia Limited ABN 39 081 678 364 (MLA), the applicant must:

- (a) be a producer; and
- (b) pay levies during the financial year in which an application for membership is made, or paid levies during either or both of the two preceding financial years.

**Producer** means a person engaged in the raising, finishing or trading of livestock for production or for live export and includes a producer of cattle\*, grainfed cattle\*, sheep (including lambs) and goats.

\*cattle means bovine animals other than buffaloes and includes calves but excludes grainfed cattle;

\*grainfed cattle means grainfed cattle that are eligible for GF or GFYG certification or third party audited certification approved by AUS-MEAT attesting that cattle are being fed to at least the AUS-MEAT minimum standards for grainfed beef.

**Levies** means levies or charges imposed on producers of livestock under the following Acts:

- (a) the Primary Industries (Customs) Charges Act 1999; and
- (b) the Primary Industries (Excise) Levies Act 1999.
