## PGS Consultancy Skills Workshop

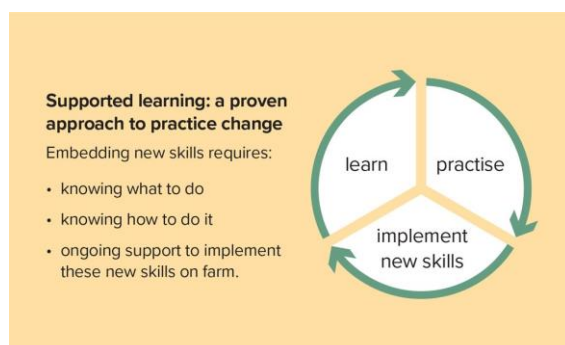
