

Feed is a major cost on beef farms

- Feed was the single largest variable costs (36%)
 - For 'Cow-Calf Farms'
 - Eastern States data (none for WA)



- Animal purchases
- Machinery (maint, deprec, contractor)
- Buildings (maint, deprec)
- Insurance, taxes

- Feed (purchased feed, fert, seed, pesticide)
- Fuel, energy, lubricants, water
- Vet & medicine
