

MEAT STANDARDS AUSTRALIA Amendment Advice 01/2020 – 1 July 2020

TO: All registered Meat Standards Australia Producers

ATTENTION: Authorised person in charge of MSA Standards.

Meat Standards Australia (MSA) registered Producers are required to adhere to the relevant sections of the current MSA Standards Manual for the processing of beef and/or sheepmeat that follow MSA pathways.

MSA advises an amendment relevant to your business has been made to;

- **MSA Standards, Section 5 – Livestock Supply.**

SUMMARY OF MAJOR AMENDMENTS

Section	Amendment
5.1.1.4 – Led Steer Pathway	Update to include and specify that unled animals associated with competitions are ineligible for this pathway.
5.1.2.2 – MSA Vendor Declaration - beef	Updated example of MSA beef vendor declaration has been added.
5.2.1.1 – On Farm Responsibilities	Update to specify that entire males are not eligible for MSA.
5.2.1.1 – On Farm Responsibilities	Transit time requirement moved from requirement to recommendation to reflect differences between states in recording transit time on NVDs.
