What you will learn

- strategies to improve lamb survival and reduce ewe wastage
- best practice management for lambing
- prepare ewes and their lambing paddocks to enable better lambing
- increase the kilograms of wool and/or lamb produced per hectare.

How you will learn

- three group workshops on the Lambs Alive Demonstration Farm (full day and two half days)
- half-day one-on-one coaching session on each participant's property
- hands-on planning and implementing your own lambing plan.

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Cost

The commercial cost of this program is:
\$1,600 + \$160 GST = \$1,760

\$1,120 + \$112 GST = \$1,232 per business
