

60TH ANNUAL CONFERENCE

Wednesday 17 and Thursday 18 July 2019 RACV Goldfields Resort, Creswick, Victoria

The bus tour on Thursday 18 July is set to be a highlight of the 60th GSSA Annual Conference. We will visit Seers Farm in Glengower which has 1500 breeding ewes plus lambs and first cross ewes and it crops about 400-525 hectares each year. The tour will include:

- Introduction to Seers farm with Jake and Rod Seers including details of the property, their approach to pasture renovation, stocking rates, what is and isn't working well, and the future of the property.
- **Species demonstration** discussing agronomic fit, use, and future trends, pros and cons, what species are best suited to differing regions and filling the winter feed gap.
- Lisa Miller from Southern Farming Systems covering lime movement through the soil profile, recommended lime rates for different soil types/scenarios and review what has occurred at the Seers property.
- Soil at the Soil Pit including sub soil discussion with Christian Bannon from South East Soil and Water on soil type, how it was formed, its limitations and soil amendments.
- Fertiliser Demonstration and Nutrient Mapping with Lee Menhenett from Incitec Pivot Fertilisers in conjunction with Precision Ag. Demonstration and discussion including lime map results, what is required for thriving pastures and nitrogen use.
- **Successful Phalaris establishment** including paddock preparation, grazing management, managing sub clover in the system and weed management.
