The day will start out in Royce's paddocks to inspect a range of medic pastures (both existing and newly sown), saltland pastures and a 2014 sown paddock scale trial comprising a large range of annual legume pastures managed in a 1:1 crop:pasture rotation.

He will be joined by Chris Poole from ALOSCA (nitrogen fixation in legumes), Angelo Loi from DPIRD (annual legume pastures) and Steve Carr from AgLime (soil pH and pastures).

After the farm tour, we will drive to Lake Grace for lunch and the afternoon session.
