In addition, MLA's expert analysts examine and interpret developments in, and prospects for, the Australian domestic market, key export markets and major competitors.

Latest news, analysis and information

Meat & Livestock Weekly

Access the very latest news, analysis and trends for livestock, domestic and key export markets in an easy-to-read and concise e-format. Includes information on buyer and competitor activity and trends.

Market analysis and forecasting

Australian cattle industry projections (quarterly) and Australian sheep industry projections (tri-annual)

A must-have for red meat industry participants interested in the prospects for the cattle and or sheep industries over the next five years. Provides forecasts for supply and demand in both domestic and export markets and examines the likely threats and opportunities facing the industry.

Red Meat Market Snapshots (living documents – available only on website)

These reports outline what is driving demand in the main markets where Australian beef and sheepmeat is consumed, and are aimed to allow producers to be more informed when having discussions with their supply chain partners.

North of the Tropic Beef Report (monthly)

Provides northern cattle producers with a clear understanding of the current market trends and drivers that are most relevant to them. Includes northern saleyard, live export and OTH price indicators, as well as slaughter statistics

LiveLink (monthly)

Detailed statistics on the livestock export industry.

Australian Livestock Export Industry Statistical Review (annually)

The Australian livestock export statistical review is an extensive statistical report outlining a detailed summary of Australian exports for cattle, sheep and goats.

Lotfeeding Brief (monthly)

Provides results from the latest ALFA/MLA lotfeeding survey.

Co-products Market Report (monthly)

Presents results from the latest co-products price survey.

Livestock market reporting

NLRS eastern states daily livestock indicators

Access the latest price indicators from the eastern states on a daily basis. All indicators are seven-day rolling averages derived from NLRS reported saleyards and include the Eastern Young Cattle Indicator (EYCI), trade steer, medium steer, heavy steer, medium cow, feeder steer, restocker lamb, Merino lamb, light lamb, trade lamb and mutton.

NLRS individual saleyard reports (weekly)

Detailed reporting of prices and yardings for individual stock categories sold at major cattle and sheep sales. Includes 'on the ground' commentary explaining local market trends.

Eastern Young Cattle Indicator (EYCI)

The Eastern Young Cattle Indicator, or EYCI, is a seven-day rolling price average of young cattle saleyards across Queensland, New South Wales and Victoria. It is expressed in cents per kilogram carcass (or dressed) weight (¢/kg cwt). The EYCI is designed to be applicable to a wide range of cattle and beef industry participants, and has sufficient diversity, both geographic and by cattle type, to provide a robust indicator of trends in the physical cattle market.

Western Young Cattle Indicator (WYCI)

The Western Young Cattle Indicator, or WYCI, is a seven-day rolling price average of young cattle saleyards across WA. It is expressed in cents per kilogram carcass (or dressed) weight (¢/kg cwt). The WYCI is directly comparable to the EYCI, and provides a robust indicator of trends in the western physical cattle market.

NLRS over-the-hooks (OTH) indicators (weekly)

Access the latest OTH trends, sourced directly from processors, generated each Monday.

NLRS slaughter reports (weekly)

Provides slaughter totals for cattle, sheep, lambs, pigs and goats generated each Monday from data collected from registered abattoirs in each state.

NLRS feeder cattle report (weekly)

Access the latest rates for sales directly to lotfeeders generated each Monday from information sourced from lotfeeders, agents and producers.

NLRS skin report (weekly)

Access weekly skin prices for lambs and sheep including Merino prices, rates for new season lambskins and crossbred skins of varying weight classes.

Industry information and structure

Statistical review (annual)

All the livestock and meat statistics you've ever wanted for Australia and other major red meat producing and trading countries.

Fast facts (annual)

Facts and figures about Australia's beef, sheepmeat and goatmeat industries, including numbers by state, exports, production and consumption levels, and Australia's position relative to other countries. Available individually for beef, sheepmeat and goatmeat.
