Live export statistics

This edition of LiveLink includes the latest trends in Australian live export trade statistics and prices. Please note that all export data over the past nine months may later be revised.

Feeder and slaughter cattle exports in May totaled almost 77,000 head, bringing the year-to-date total to 291,000 head, 37% below year-ago volumes. However, May exports were the largest monthly shipment of feeder and slaughter cattle this calendar year, underpinned by a significant increase in exports to Vietnam.

Cattle exports continue to be restricted by high prices and reduced availability, as well as a variety of inmarket challenges. Vietnamese and Indonesian importers remain reluctant to enter the market with the high prices on offer.

While greater in May, high Australian cattle prices continue to limit shipments to Vietnam; year-to-May exports were 35% lower year-on-year, at 72,000 head.

Year-to-May shipments to Indonesia were back 21%, at 198,000 head, notwithstanding a modest increase in exports month-on-month. The presence of Indian Buffalo Meat (IBM) and supply limitations out of Australia remain prominent factors in reduced livestock exports to the region.

Current wet market prices for IBM in the Greater Jakarta area continue to vary and range from IDR 75,000-110,000/kg, while fresh beef trades at a premium from IDR 105,000-125,000/kg.


#### **Data specifications**

Due to the timing of live export trade data being released, both Australian Bureau of Statistics (ABS) and Department of Agriculture and Water Resources (DAWR) data is used in this report. The most recent month and, at times, second most recent month trade data comes from DAWR. This data is then updated when ABS data is released.

- \* In October 2015, the ABS did not disclose feeder and slaughter cattle trade data to Vietnam, China and Japan. For this month, individual country shipments have been estimated by MLA. In addition, trade data by individual port was also not disclosed in October 2015 this data is aggregated under "Unknown" port.
- \*\* DAWR does not report on individual ports. Port data is updated when released by the ABS.

All pricing data is collected by Meat and Livestock Australia from a range of sources.

Figure 2 Live export feeder cattle prices





Figure 5 Sheep exports by region - past 12 months




Figure 6 WA live export wether price

May sheep exports were 144,000 head, back on the previous month as a result of reduced shipments to Kuwait.

May exports were low compared to April (195,000 head), when importers were preparing for Ramadan (26 May – 24 June). Year-to-May exports remain unchanged year-on-year, totalling 705,000 head.






