

## Canada Meat Market Report

- Supply and Price Situation for Domestic and Imported Beef -

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## At a Glance: Imported Beef Market

### Market Situation

Similar to the US imported beef availability in Canada has been limited and prices have been trending higher in recent weeks. Participants continue to note a shortfall in offerings from all suppliers, particularly New Zealand. Increased competition from China and lower than expected slaughter have limited offerings. Currently overseas packers are well sold in March and early April and looking to book product for April arrival. Seasonally cow slaughter in New Zealand is higher in March and April but good moisture conditions could impact availability, similar to what happened a year ago. Asian markets have also been more active to start the year and this is seen as impacting availability in Canada. New Zealand exports to China were up 50% y/y in December and participants speculate that January shipments into that market continued to trend higher. Demand for round cuts reported as good, especially for spring deliveries. Inquiries for flats were not countered, as this product is currently getting higher prices in Asian markets.

### Imported Prices:


Imported prices were up across the board for January, averaging roughly 8% higher for trimmings and 2% for cuts vs the same time last year. 65CL trim was up 25% to US\$1.49 /lb. Higher prices for domestic fat trim bolstered imported trim values.

### Imported Beef Volume:

Imported beef volumes are still down for the period ending 18th February, 2018 compared to last year. Product from the USA is down 12% to 15,380 MT; the decline coming exclusively from fresh/chilled beef. After a slow 2017, New Zealand and Australian imports are up on a year on year basis, albeit from a small baseline. Frozen beef from New Zealand was up 20% to 2,334 MT, while 2,129 MT frozen beef arrived from Australia, up 75% from the same time last year. Overall imports from Australia and New Zealand are pretty much even at this point. Uruguay is off to a very slow start, with imports down 75% from last year. China now buys about half of all Uruguayan beef exports.


### YTD Canadian Beef Imports from the US

Data is through week ending February 17th, 2018 vs. Same Period in 2017




### YTD Canadian Beef Imports from Australia

## At a Glance: Canadian Domestic Beef Market


### Fed and non-fed Slaughter Trends:

Steer and heifer slaughter has been tracking well above year ago levels, largely a function of higher on feed numbers but also robust demand in both domestic and export markets. A larger on feed inventory should continue to support higher fed cattle slaughter in the spring. Steer slaughter in the last four weeks averaged 23,053 head/wk, 8.4% above year ago levels and also 1.3% higher than the five year average. Heifer slaughter, on the other hand, averaged 14,651 head/wk, only slightly higher than a year ago. Combined steer/heifer slaughter in the last four weeks was on average 39,639 head/wk, 5.3% higher than the same period a year ago and 3.3% higher than the five year average. The strong marketing rate and lighter weight placements last year have contributed to a decline in average steer weights and a slower growth in beef production. The average steer weights in the last four weeks was 910 lb./dressed carcass, 0.9% lower than the same period a year ago.



Non-fed cattle slaughter has been similar to year ago levels so far this year. For the last four weeks non-fed cattle slaughter has averaged 11,290 head/wk, just 0.2% higher than last year but still some 6.2% higher than the five year average.

### Cattle on Feed Inventories

Dry conditions in Alberta and Saskatchewan last summer and fall forced producers to push cattle into feed-lots earlier than normal and bolstered on feed supplies in the process. However, the Canadian calf crop has been near 4.3 million head in the last two years and we do not expect to see a significant increase in cattle on feed placements in 2018. Indeed, following the sharp increase in placements between July and November, placements have been trending lower. Total placements in January were 76,053 head, 5% lower than a year ago. This follows a 20% decline in placements in December. Total cattle on feed on February 1 were 879,701, 5.7% higher than a year ago. On December 1 the total on feed supply was 974,881 head, 12% higher on a y/y basis.






### CANADIAN CATTLE EXPORTS TO THE US: SLAUGHTER COWS

### CANADIAN CATTLE EXPORTS TO THE US: FED STEER & HEIFER






## CUMULATIVE BEEF SHIPMENTS TO UNITED STATES




## CUMULATIVE BEEF SHIPMENTS TO HONG KONG
