Beef Co-products

Due to COVID-19 some of the usual respondents were unavailable to provide their data which may impact the veracity of some price averages.

Beef offal prices were generally firmer across the range of products, however prices for all tripe products were softer .

Head offal

Prices for most head offal products were firmer this month. Head meat averaged 4.77/kg which was 55¢/kg firmer year-on-year but 26¢/kg lower than last month. Cheek meat was 58¢/kg dearer than year-ago levels, averaging 6.23kg, and 11¢/kg firmer than last month.

Lip export prices to the US and Mexico firmed 35¢/kg month-on-month, to average \$3.05/kg but 29¢/kg down on last year. Halal lips averaged \$3.14/kg, up 51¢/kg from last month but 57¢/kg lower than September 2019.





Figure 1: Trends in beef head offal prices

Beef offal trends

Omasum eased 31¢/kg from last month, to average 6.32/kg, down 39¢/kg from year-ago prices. Halal omasum averaged 6.36/kg, down 1.91/kg year-on-year.

Halal tripe pieces averaged \$2.86 down 67¢/kg year-on-year and 31¢kg down from last month. Non-halal tripe pieces were 78¢/kg down year-on-year and \$1.37/kg softer than August to average \$2.46/kg. Honeycomb tripe averaged \$7.24/kg to be 47¢/kg below year ago prices but 39¢/kg above last month.





Beef offal trends continued...

Aorta traded firmer to average \$7.63/kg up 40¢/kg month-on-month and down 57¢/kg from September 2019 price.


Heart prices were up from last month, averaging \$2.72/kg, to be 41¢/kg above year-ago levels and 39¢/kg above August prices. Halal hearts averaged \$3.00/kg, firming 67¢/kg month-on-month, and up 62¢/kg from September 2019.

Kidneys averaged 88¢/kg, down 27¢/kg on August price and 12¢/kg softer than a year ago. Non-halal lungs were reported at \$1.77/kg up 17¢/kg from year ago levels and 9¢/kg firmer month-on-month, while halal lungs averaged \$2.52/kg to be 52¢/kg firmer month-on-month and 84¢/kg higher than September 2019.


Figure 4: Trends in beef offal prices

Liver prices averaged \$1.25/kg, 11¢/kg up month-on-month and 11¢/kg softer than year-ago levels. Halal livers were up 33¢/kg from last month's price to average \$1.43kg, down 13¢/kg on last year prices.

Figure 5: Trends in beef offal prices




Japanese and Korean Offals

Tongue prices were 66¢/kg up from August to average \$9.86/kg, and \$3.20/kg below year-ago levels.

Thick skirt was 74¢/kg softer year-on-year and 82¢/kg lower than last month, averaging \$8.66/kg. Thin skirt averaged \$8.60/kg, up 28¢/kg from August and 61¢/kg below year-ago prices.

Rumen pillars eased with heavy weight product averaging \$8.18/kg, down \$1.65/kg month-on-month and \$9.00/kg cheaper than September 2019 levels.


Figure 6: Trends in Japanese offal prices



Tails and Tendons

Tail prices to Korea firmed 37¢/kg from last month, averaging \$10.77/kg, to be 58¢/kg above year-ago levels. Halal tails averaged \$10.45/kg, up 72¢/kg from last month and 45¢/kg above year-ago prices. Tendons averaged \$7.23 this month to be 23¢/kg up on year ago price and 50¢/kg softer month-on-month.

Sheep offal prices have been lightly reported for some time.



Sheep offal

Sheep hearts averaged \$3.45/kg, up 50¢/kg month-on-month and 45¢/kg dearer than year-ago levels. Sheep kidneys and sheep livers were not reported.


Sheep tripe was reported to average \$5.10/kg, which is 70¢/kg above year ago prices and up 57¢/kg month-on-month, whilst long cut tongues were reported at \$5.00/kg.

Lamb runners were reported at 4.25/piece up 5¢/piece month-on-month while sheep runners returned 3.00/ piece even with last month.







above September 2019 levels. Blood meal averaged \$922/tonne, up \$78/tonne compared with last year's price, and \$98/tonne firmer month-on-month.

Tallow prices were firmer, with the price for 1% FFA tallow averaging \$1020/tonne, up \$46/tonne from August and \$145/tonne above year-ago prices.

The hide market showed some small signs of recovery with improved demand from China.

Local prices for hides firmed slightly with most lines still low in value but hopefully there is some light at the end of the tunnel.




Figure 13: Trends in hide prices (East Coast Ex Works)
